## Mesgi'g Ugju's'n 2 Wind Farm Project on the Unorganized Rivière-Nouvelle Territory The Sessions Begin March 12, 2024

**Quebec City, February 22, 2024** – The Commission of Inquiry of the Bureau d'audiences publiques sur l'environnement (BAPE) announces the beginning of the public sessions of the targeted consultation on [Mesgi'g Ugju's'n 2 Wind Farm Project on the Unorganized Rivière-Nouvelle Territory by MESGI'G UGJU'S'N 2 \(MU2\) WIND FARM S.E.C.](#) on March 12, at 7:00 p.m, at the Centre Polyvalent, in Pointe-à-la-Croix. Sessions may continue on subsequent days depending on the needs of the public and the Commission.

The sessions will take place in the presence of the project's initiator and resource persons who will answer questions from the public and the Commission. Participants will also be able to share their views on the project. Those who wish to do so are invited to register now to summarize a brief or give a verbal opinion to the Commission. They can also send them a brief, a comment or a commented image.

The consultation will specifically target the cumulative effects on wildlife habitats, the dismantling of the wind farm, and the impacts of infrasound and low-frequency noise on wildlife.

### **How to Participate**

- To ask a question or give a point of view spontaneously in person or remotely, participants need only to register in the registry available during the sessions.
