Mesgi'g Ugju's'n 2 Wind Farm Project on the Unorganized Rivière-Nouvelle Territory Review of the Targeted Consultation

Quebec City, March 20, 2024 – The Commission of Inquiry of the Bureau d'audiences publiques sur l'environnement (BAPE), chaired by Antoine Morissette, draws up a positive assessment of the targeted consultation on [Mesgi'g Ugju's'n 2 Wind Farm Project on the Unorganized Rivière-Nouvelle Territory by MESGI'G UGJU'S'N 2 \(MU2\) WIND FARM S.E.C.](#)

During the 4 hours and 30 minutes session held on March 12, the Commission met with the public, the project initiator, and representatives of the Ministère de l'Environnement, de la Lutte contre les changements climatiques, de la Faune et des Parcs and the Ministère des Ressources naturelles et des Forêts. About twenty citizens attended the session, either in person or remotely.

On this occasion, the public could ask questions and express their views on the project. The questions that were raised included the cumulative impact of noise emitted by wind turbines, the species that could be affected by infrasound and low-frequency sounds and their measurement, efforts to promote the social acceptability of the project and the dismantling of the wind farm. In addition, 4 participants summarized a brief or expressed an opinion verbally. In total, the Commission received [8 briefs](#) and [2 commentaries](#).

The Commission would like to thank all those who participated in its work. Their questions and their points of view can change the way it sees the project.

The Commission is currently continuing its analysis and writing its report, which will be filed to the Ministre de l'Environnement, de la Lutte contre les changements climatiques, de la Faune et des Parcs, Benoit Charette, no later than June 11, 2024.
