

CHANGES TO THE SCHEDULE OF PUBLIC SESSIONS

Québec, November 15, 2006 – Please note that certain changes have been made to the schedule of the public sessions of the second part of the hearing of the Bureau d'audiences publiques sur l'environnement (BAPE) dealing with the *Belmont and Magpie lakes massif, Lac aux Sauterelles knolls, Guernesé lake foothills and Brador hills biodiversity reserve projects in the Lower North Shore Plateau natural province*. Indeed, the session planned in Blanc-Sablon has been moved to the **Salle communautaire de Blanc-Sablon located at 1550, boulevard Docteur-Camille-Marcoux**.
