

Cancellation of the public session in Saint-Augustin

Québec, November 16, 2006 – Please note that the public session in Saint-Augustin appearing in the schedule pertaining to the second part of the hearing of the Bureau d'audiences publiques sur l'environnement (BAPE) dealing with the *Belmont and Magpie lakes massif, Lac aux Sauterelles knolls, Guernesé lake foothills and Brador hills biodiversity reserve projects in the Lower North Shore Plateau natural province* has been **cancelled**.
