Horne 5 project in Rouyn-Noranda by Ressources Falco Ltée Commission announces public site visit

Quebec City, August 20, 2024 – As part of the BAPE public hearing on Ressources Falco Ltée's Horne 5 project in Rouyn-Noranda, the commission of inquiry composed of Joseph Zayed, chair, Martin Lessard and Geneviève Meloche, commissioners, has requested a site visit to key locations related to the project. This visit, lasting approximately two hours, is open to the public. The tour will include both bus and walking segments, and no special protective gear is necessary. Participants will be able to ask questions about the visited sites; however, discussions about the project itself will be reserved for the public sessions.
