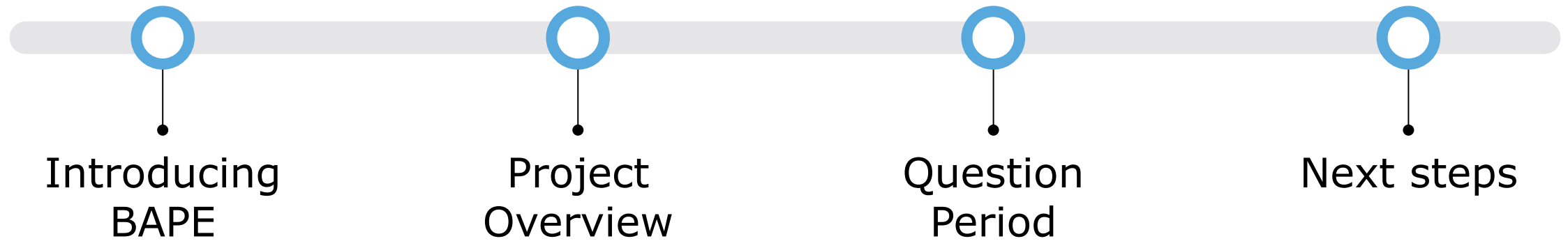

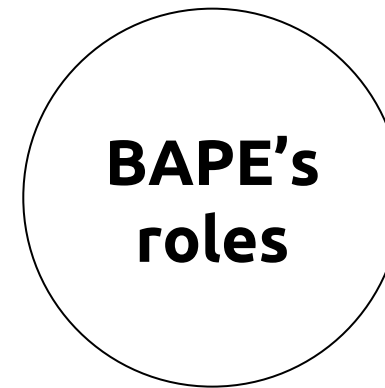

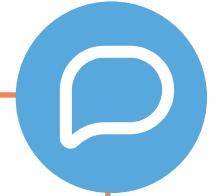

- Any person, group or municipality

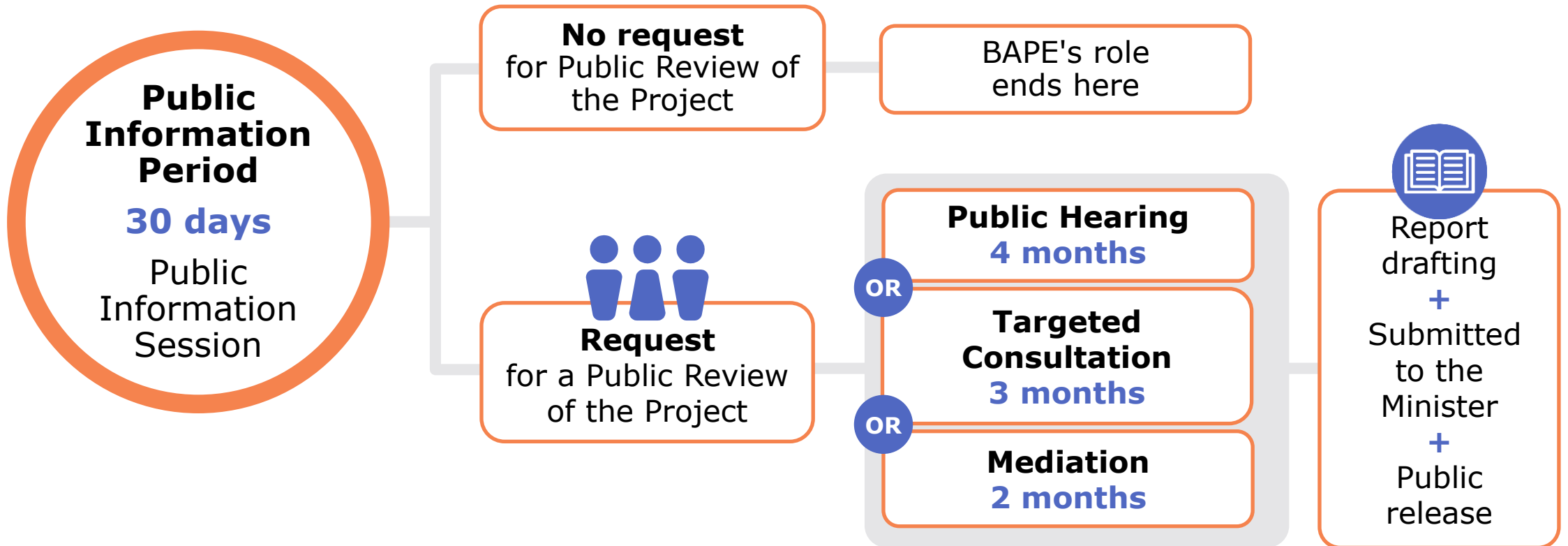
▶ What must a request contain?

- Reason for a request
- Interest in the environment affected by the project

▶ How to submit a request?

- By mail ou email
- Addressed to the Minister responsible for the Environment
- No later than the last day of the Public Information Period:
April 7, 2026, at 11:59 p.m.

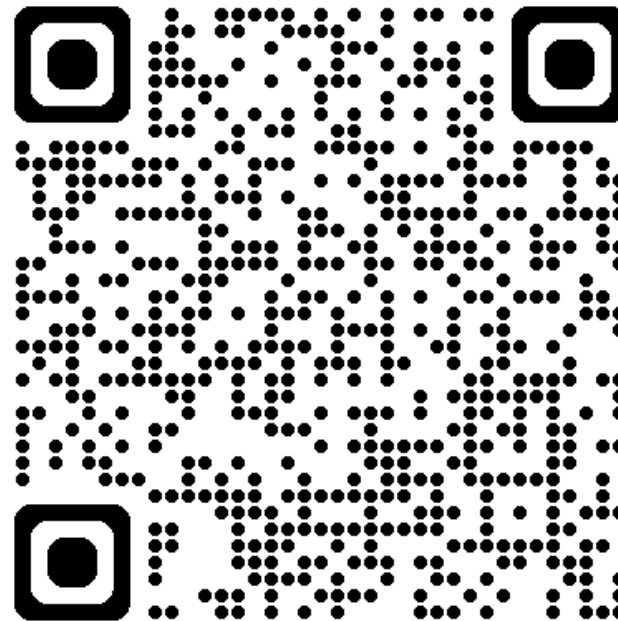
