The BAPE Has Published Its Report on the Grosse-Île Wind Farm Project in the Communauté maritime des Îles-de-la-Madeleine

Québec, June 23, 2026 – At the request of the ministre de l'Environnement, de la Lutte contre les changements climatiques, de la Faune et des Parcs, Pascale Déry, the Bureau d'audiences publiques sur l'environnement (BAPE) has published its investigation and public hearing report on the Grosse-Île Wind Farm Project, to be carried out by Grosse-Île Wind Power L.P. in the territory of the municipality of Grosse-Île, in the Communauté maritime des Îles-de-la-Madeleine.

The Commission of Inquiry responsible for examining the project was composed of Mireille Paul, Chair, and Stella Leney, Commissioner. Its four-month mandate ran from February 9 to June 9, 2026.

The report contains a summary of the opinions expressed by participants, as well as the Commission's analysis, findings and opinions.

Two summary documents are also available: **At a Glance** provides a one-page overview of the report, while **Highlights** provides more detail, particularly on the Commission's findings and opinions.
